**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES WHO ARE APPEARING
FOR OBJECTIVE TYPE TEST TO THE POST OF PRESIDENT/MEMBER
/WOMAN MEMBER SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON 07.09.2021**

01. Candidate, who is tested positive for COVID-19 and is under mandatory quarantine as on the date of Test, should submit his/her Covid-19 report and send a certificate from the DHO or treated Doctor about his/her fitness to attend the Test, to the Secretary of the Selection Committee by sending email to rrecruithckb@gmail.com well in advance, for making necessary arrangements for his/her separate sitting for the Test at the Test place already allotted to him/her.
02. Candidates who are from Containment Zone or who are/were in contact with Covid-19 patient and considered as primary or secondary contact should send information, along with necessary details, to the Secretary of the Selection Committee by sending email to rrecruithckb@gmail.com well in advance for making necessary arrangements for their separate sitting in the Test Center, already allotted to them.
03. The Candidates while entering the test center premises, shall show either hard copy or the soft copy of the vaccination certificate for having received at least one dose of COVID 19 Vaccination. Further, the candidates, who have not received or were prevented from receiving at least one dose of Covid-19 vaccine, will be permitted to enter the Test Center premises subject to production of Covid-19 negative report, which is obtained 72 hours before the Test.

04. The entry and exit of candidates who are attending the Test shall be only through the designated gates of the Test Center.
05. Only the Candidates are allowed to enter the Test Center premises on production of admission card and subject to instructions as specified above.
06. Candidates will be allowed entry to the Test Center from 1.00 PM and onwards on the scheduled date to avoid the congregation at the entrance of the Test Center.
07. In view of current Covid-19 situation, the candidates travelling overnight by public conveyance like Buses and Trains are advised to wear clean and fresh clothes in order to maintain personal hygiene.
08. Candidates shall wear N95 masks throughout their stay at the Test Center. The candidates without N95 masks will not be allowed entry to the Test Center. The candidates shall ensure that they will not remove masks in the Test hall and while writing the Test.
09. The candidates shall ensure in maintaining social distance throughout their stay at the Test Center and also outside the Test Center, before and after the Test.
10. Candidates entering the Test Center premises are instructed to cooperate with Medical Screening team and Paramedical Volunteers.
11. Candidates shall leave the Test Center immediately after the Test.
